COMPLETING OUR BUILDING

My son Gianni started at Turning Pointe on February 9, 2021, right after they completed their final stage of interior construction... Since then, my husband and I have seen dramatic changes in his overall behavior, attitude, and personality. One thing that is different about Turning Pointe from other schools, is its dedicated staff and team members. I really feel that this team of professionals working daily with my son, has helped him improve in so many aspects of life. Gianni is now given new opportunities and experiences daily that allow him to thrive, and in the past, he did not get these opportunities and was very limited in what he could do.

Now, all the activities Gianni does at Turning Pointe are very hands-on and engaging, and because of this, he can interact with others better. Turning Pointe has given my son the opportunity to learn from the best and succeed in his life. My husband and I are very grateful for what Turning Pointe has to offer for my son. Gianni attending this school was truly a blessing to my family, and his progress is seen by everyone he meets. He has flourished in ways we always hoped for because of Turning Pointe.







ADULT LEARNERS

Turning Pointe continues to pilot partnerships and programs to best serve adults with autism living in the community. In the spring of 2021, through a collaboration with Parents Alliance Employment Project, a cohort of 8 students completed skill-based employability training at Turning Pointe and transitioned into community-based internship opportunities! In the fall, an additional 5 students began their employability training, quickly mastering skills to promote independence and success as they look to transition into future employment opportunities. Following a year of remote instruction, our Career Development Camp moved back to in-person learning with 6 learners maximizing their skills in the areas of social communication, independent living, and employability.

The Adult Day Pilot continued to employ work-eligible participants for our enterprise with Two Brothers Coffee Roasters. Adult Day employment opportunities continue to grow as coffee sales were expanded to include packaging k-cups. The supported employment skillbuilding of the Adult Day Pilot has been crucial in sustaining and expanding Turning Pointe Enterprises. We are excited to expand our number of Adult Day employees in the near future to fill the growing demand for coffee orders. The pilot struggled to keep pace with the student needs in a labor shortage for students who are not employed, despite great effort to secure CARF accreditation this year. As a pilot, it will continue to evolve as we are able to meet needs.






STAYING SAFE

My son's name is Dominic, he is 14, non-verbal, self-injurious, has a diagnosis of seizure disorder, and has autism. As Dominic grew he acquired more and more self-injurious behavior. pained me to watch him hurt himself so severely that I almost couldn't function. About 3.5 years ago Dominic's selfinjurious behavior grew so severe that I knew the public schools could no longer keep my son safe. That's when I found Turning Pointe. Every day I am amazed at the commitment, excitement, hope and clarity that Turning Pointe brings to both of our lives. They provide myself and my son with a safe haven and I can finally take a breath without fear for his safety.

Outside of Dominic's daily school services Turning Pointe provides a free respite program to their families. It is a few hours outside of allotted school time for our children to be free, with the staff that truly loves what they do. This program is a gift to my son...fun and protection outside of our 4 walls, the play dates that he never got to go on. It is also a gift to our family, helping give me time to become a better mom to both of my children by spending one on one time with his brother. Or even a few hours to find myself again.

In times of hardship, which can be daily. I ask myself "What would Turning Pointe do?" They are the flashlight leading me in the darkest hours.


